

Balik Kabuhayan (Livelihood Restoration)

The DOLE assists self-employed workers in the informal economy restore their lost livelihood resources due to natural calamities and disasters.

Who are qualified for this project?

Self-employed workers or workers in the informal economy affected by natural calamities and disasters.

What does DOLE provide?

The DOLE, through its provincial offices, provides the following services:

- **Acquisition of productive resources** in the form of equipment, raw materials, and tools that can be used by the eligible beneficiaries;
- **Trainings, orientation and advisories** on the entrepreneurship development, business planning, productivity improvement, workers' safety and health, and networking and business alliance;

Who are the Program Implementors?

The DOLE provincial and field offices, implements the program in partnership with Accredited Co-Partners (ACPs). The ACPs serve as the conduits of financial assistance and act as program partners particularly in building the capacities of the workers.

The ACPs can be non-government organizations (NGOs) including church-based organizations, peoples' organizations (POs) and the academe, the local government units (LGUs) and other government agencies (GAs).
