## TRIPARTITE INDUSTRIAL PEACE COUNCIL (TIPC)

Executive Order No. 403 issued on May 30, 1990 by then President Corazon C. Aquino establishes the Tripartite Industrial Peace Council (TIPC) to attain industrial peace through meaningful tripartite consultations among the representatives from Labor, Employer and Government sectors in the formulation and implementation of labor and social policies.

The National TIPC is composed of the Secretary of Labor and Employment as Chairman and twelve (12) representatives each from the tripartite sectors, to be designated by the President.

On the other hand, the Regional TIPC is composed of the Regional Director as Chairman and representatives each from the tripartite sectors, to be designated by their respective organizations/sectors.

The Council has the following functions (1) To monitor the full implementation and sectoral compliance with the provisions of the Industrial Peace Accord (IPA); and (2) To formulate for submission to Congress, through the DOLE, tripartite views on labor and social concerns, as well as present tripartite position and views on pending relevant legislative proposal.
